2. HWY 31 Diablo Package

Discussion regarding south bound to east bound as Nasdaq. Turning movement data has been collected on Nasdaq westbound to south. South bound to east pending. Wilkes data pending.

At a five lane Hwy 31; right/right movements become a greater safety concern and less of a throughput concern.

Discussion on rolling out Diablo package one improvement at a time

Discussion on updating resolution 16-15 due to concerns raised by potential development in corridor.

Discussion on timing of potential update. November discussed

3. School Traffic Management Strategy, Review Scope of Work

Work is pending. Expecting November deliverable.


Roundtable
