

**CITY OF SPRING HILL
COMMISSION OF SPRING HILL
MEETING MINUTES**

Thursday, March 3, 2016

The meeting of the Arts Commission of Spring Hill was called to order by Chairman Ricky Newman at 4:45 p.m.

Members in attendance were Ricky Newman, Herb Grogan, Jill Garrett, Steve Chessor, and Danielle Bonds

Also in attendance were Shannon Ford of the TN Arts Commission and Quint Qualls of the Spring Hill Home Page

A motion to approve of the February meeting minutes was brought by Ricky Newman and seconded by Steve Chessor. The motion passed by a majority vote.

Chairman Comments:

The Chairman reviewed the various hand-outs that each member received at the beginning of the meeting.

The Chairman recognized the Arts Commission of Spring Hill's 1 year anniversary.

Old News:

The Chairman updated the group on the "Film Prov" project regarding ticket availability, poster distribution, and who will be table attendants at the events for March 14, April 11, and May 8.

The Commission discussed final details for preparation of hosting The Regional Arts Mixer "Corridor of the Arts" being held at Jonathan's Restaurant on March 10th at 5:30 pm.

It was agreed that the Commission meeting time will remain at 4:45 and the Jill Garrett will be a back up to Ricky Newman to get to City Hall before 4:30 when the building is locked.

It was mentioned that the final budget request was voted on and passed via proxy. It was submitted to Victor Lay and Mayor Graham on Feb. 11th. Commission members were encouraged to attend the April budget meeting of Spring Hill.

The Chairman updated the group about the upcoming presentation to Kiwanis Club on March 8th at 12 noon.

The Chairman handed out samples of the TN Arts Commission National Arts Impact Survey and discussed how the Commission can utilize them to collect data from consumers to identify how the arts are impacting our area.

The Chairman updated the Commission on our progress partnering with Kids Arts Festival of Tennessee taking place on June 4, 2016. It was decided that at next month's meeting a decision will be made on what activity the Commission will offer at the Art Stop booth at the festival.

Herb Grogan has collected a list of names of people who support the building of SPACE. This list will act as a base list for building a membership for SPACE. He requested that the Commission members each take part in collecting contact information on each supporter.

The dinner show fundraiser "Moments of Broadway" is set for Saturday, Sept. 17th at Trinity United Methodist Church in Spring Hill. Doors will open at 5:30 and the show will begin at 6 pm. Spring Hill HarMoniX, the Spring Hill Orchestra, and Stegmans' School of Performing Arts have already agreed to be part of the entertainment. Rehearsals will take place that morning from 10-12 and dinner set up from 4-5:30. A dinner set-up crew and a rehearsal director's crew are needed to make this a successful event

Guest speaker Shannon Ford from the TN Arts Commission presented more information on the importance of the TN Arts Commission National Arts Impact Survey. He also shared with the Commission the variety of grant opportunities offered by the state level organization. He made suggestions for which grants best suited the needs of the Arts Commission of Spring Hill.
