**Item #1** Consider request from Highland Corporation for Fast Stop Markets, 2100 Wall Street, Spring Hill, TN, for an on premise beer permit. (This business currently has an off-premise permit and would like both.)

Motion to approve by Vice Mayor Hull; motion seconded by Chad Whittenburg.

Alderman Whittenburg asked about the amount they are being sampled.

Highland Corporation Vice President, Seth Blanks, was present to address this request. He stated that they are selling growlers and they want to try before they commit to the large amount.

Alderman Whittenburg asked that he discussed process of selling.


Mr. Blanks stated that the cashiers card customers. After customer makes selection, they heat seal the growler. Cashiers are required to do alcohol sales training that is detailed on underage sales. They also have a probationary period to see how sales are done. He stated they do not hire anyone under the age of 18.

Alderman Whittenburg warned that the city does do stings.

Alderman Williams discussed half ounce and one ounce. State limit is one ounce. She offered to make a motion to amend to one ounce. He stated they are fine either way.


Vote to allow one ounce samples; 6/0. Motion carried.
