Matt Deep spoke to favor widening Hwy 31 north all the way to south Franklin

William Lovett spoke to favor limiting overall growth as a short term fix

Diane Taylor inquired as to interconnectivity policy

David Goodman inquired regarding development on Wilkes Ln


Ixa Dean inquired regarding PD Patrol during peak hours to assist traffic control
