Motion to approve by Vice Mayor Hull; seconded by Alderman Hudson.


Representatives from the company were present. Alderman Whittenburg welcomed them and asked questions regarding safeguards to prevent underage beer sales, training, etc.

The manager stated that they are trained and required to get an ABC card. They have training every six months. They have been in stings and never been cited. They will be scanning driver's license. They have a zero tolerance policy for servers who sell underage.


Alderman Zemek asked if it is at the discretion of the server or if all are scanned. They stated that it is at the discretion of the server. She suggested it be mandatory for all.
