**A RESOLUTION TO ESTABLISH A TRANSPORTATION ADVISORY COMMITTEE WHOSE PURPOSE IS TO ASSIST IN THE DEVELOPMENT OF A STRATEGIC TRANSPORTATION PLAN AND RECOMMEND ANNUAL TRANSPORTATION PRIORITIES FOR CIP FUNDING FOR THE CITY OF SPRING HILL, TENNESSEE**


**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the members shall be appointed at large with all appointments to be made by the Mayor.


