

SUBJECT: Recommendations for Amendments to MPO Major Roadway Network
DATE: June 29, 2012

The City of Spring Hill Board of Mayor and Aldermen constituted a Transportation Advisory Committee (TAC) in November 2011 (Resolution 11-122) with a stated purpose “to assist in the development of a strategic transportation plan and to make recommendations regarding the priority of improvements to the City of Spring Hill, Tennessee.”

Pursuant to the Nashville Area Metropolitan Planning Organization’s Call for Amendments to MPO Major Roadway Network, the City of Spring Hill TAC makes the following recommendations for Amendment to the Major Roadway Network facility functionality classification for roadways within the City of Spring Hill:

- 1. Add Buckner Lane from Thompsons Station Road to Port Royal Road**
- 2. Add Buckner Road from US-31 (SR-6) to Buckner Lane**
- 3. Add Thompsons Station Road from US-31 (SR-6) to US-431**
- 4. Add Port Royal Road from Kedron Road to Buckner Road**
- 5. Add Commonwealth Drive from Duplex Road to US-31 (SR-6)**
- 6. Add Miles Johnson Parkway from US-31 (SR-6) to Kedron Road**
- 7. Add Campbell Station Parkway from US-31 (SR-6) to Port Royal Road**
