# What is a CMA?

- ▣ CMA is an acronym for:  
**Corridor Management Agreement**
- ▣ A corridor management agreement provides a framework for organizations and governments to work collaboratively in the management of a geographical area. In this case as it relates to mutual transportation matters along I-65 and SR-6 (Hwy 31)

# What does this CMA do?

- ▣ Outlines the mutual objectives of the signatory organizations and governments.
- ▣ Establishes a steering committee to implement the CMA and make recommendations to the signatories.

# What does this CMA do? (cont)

- ▣ Establishes specific priorities for roadway design and capacity.
  - Improvements to the intersection of SR 6 and Thompson's Station Road.
  - Construction of an I-65 Interchange located at the extension of Buckner Road and Construction of westerly connection to Lewisburg Pike.
  - Improvements to intersection of SR 6 and Buckner Road.
  - Improvements to intersection of a realigned Critz Lane and SR 6.

# What does it not do?

- ▣ It does not grant any statutory authority.
- ▣ It does not bind signatories.
  - The CMA can be amended.
  - Signatories can withdraw.
- ▣ It does not appropriate or obligate funds.

# Next Steps

- ▣ Adoption by the signatories.
- ▣ Appointment of a committee representative.
- ▣ Committee will meet and establish a regular schedule of meetings, rules, and procedures.
