Discussion of formal recommendations, Project Smash/USTA proposal

Historic Commission should formally memorialize findings and recommendations, as the three emails that were sent were not sufficient without a vote. Must quote appropriate codes, consider recommendations of Battlefield Task Force and Crossings study. Context of Spring Hill Battlefield is important and must be spelled out formally. Recommendations must be only on what's been submitted and presented, not outside discussions. Developers have already made some suggested changes, such as stake and rail fencing, road buffer distancing from battlefield and preserving tree lines.

With input from all, Alicia Fitts moved to approve the findings as depicted in the letter to be signed by Co-Chairs and delivered to City Recorder. Jonathan Duda seconded. Passed unanimously, 5-0.
