Citizens Election Task Force
Minutes - October 18, 2023

Call to order

Present: Alicia Fitts, Chairman; Alan Cook, Vice Chairman; Nanci Gregg, Secretary; Lorraine Johnson, Ken Mikula, Brandon McCulloch, Jim Tew, Beth Vriesman.

Chairman Fitts called the meeting to order.

The minutes from October 3 were amended and approved.

Alicia Fitts and Alan Cook had submitted proposed separate motions via email prior to the meeting. But prior to the meeting Fitts and Cook met and worked out a compromise motion to put before the task force. Alan Cook and Alicia Fitts created a memo/document for approval by the Citizens Election Task Force and intended to be presented to members of the Board of Mayor and Aldermen.

Mike Mikula moved that members of the Task Ford approve the Eight (8) Ward-Based Alderman Proposal; Beth Vriesman seconded the motion. Task force members present approved the proposal unanimously.

Additionally Mike Mikula moved that members of the Task Force approve "Other Suggestions," a document suggesting a new special census may need to be conducted prior to the next city election so that city wards may be redistricted in keeping with the Constitutional principal "one man one vote." The suggestions also list increasing voter participation be a goal of the task force and of BOMA. Beth Vriesman seconded the motion.

Chairman Fitts encouraged members of the Task Force to attend the next BOMA meeting on October 30 at 6 p.m. when the approved documents will be presented.

The meeting was adjourned.
