

**RESOLUTION 23-139**

**A RESOLUTION TO FAVORABLY RECOMMEND APPROVAL AND RATIFY THE SPRING HILL WILLIAMSON COUNTY URBAN GROWTH BOUNDARY EXPANSION.**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Spring Hill has worked collaboratively with all Williamson County municipalities to present the proposed Williamson County Urban Growth Boundary.

**WHEREAS**, the City of Spring Hill has followed the Urban Growth Boundary Process as identified in Public Chapter 1101, that stipulates the Growth Plan Approval Process.

**WHEREAS**, the City has publicly notified in accordance with state statute, by placing a newspaper ad within the Williamson Herald;

**WHEREAS**, the City provided additional notice as a form of best practice, by sending mailed notifications to properties effected by the proposed expansion of the Urban Growth Boundary.

**WHEREAS**, the City finds the proposed Growth Boundary to be appropriate given the growth across Middle Tennessee and the need to ensure that future growth can be strategically planned for and supported by the City;

**WHEREAS**, City staff recommends ratification of the proposed Urban Growth Boundary as indicated in Exhibit A;

**WHEREAS**, upon ratification of the Urban Growth Boundary, the city will forward this resolution to Local Government Planning Advisory Committee (LGPAC) for final approval;


**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, the City of Spring Hill Board of Mayor and Aldermen:


