A RESOLUTION AMENDING RESOLUTION 23-142 TO AUTHORIZE THE PURCHASE OF A VEHICLE FOR PUBLIC WORKS ADMINISTRATION ENGINEER THROUGH STATE CONTRACT

WHEREAS, the City of Spring Hill Public Works Administration desires to purchase a vehicle (SUV or truck) from a vendor of their choice through State contract; and

WHEREAS, on August 7, 2023, the Board of Mayor and Aldermen approved Resolution 23-142, a Resolution authorizing the purchase of a vehicle for the Public Works Administration Engineer that was added in the FY 23/24 budget; and

WHEREAS, the State contract pricing for the vehicle shall not exceed \$37,000.00 and


WHEREAS, funding for the purchase of the vehicle is budgeted in the FY 23/24 budget year in the Public Works Administration department (110-43100-59411).

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the City of Spring Hill Board of Mayor and Aldermen, authorize the purchase of a vehicle (SUV or truck) from a vendor of the departments choice not to exceed a total price of \$37,000.00 through State contract.

RE: **To approve amended resolution 23-142 authorizing the purchase of a vehicle (SUV or Truck) for Public Works Administration Engineer through State contract**

PURPOSE:

To approve the purchase of a vehicle for the Public Works Administration Engineer through (Sourcewell) State contract.

BACKGROUND:

In August, 2023, BOMA approved Resolution 23-142 authorizing the purchase of a work vehicle for the Public Works Administration Engineer for \$28,000.00. Due to the drastic increase in vehicle pricing, Public Works Administration requested and received additional funds in budget amendment No. 1 to cover the excess cost of a vehicle. As many vehicles are not available for purchase currently, staff is asking to purchase an SUV or Pick Up Truck from a vendor under Sourcewell/State Contract that has inventory. The cost shall not exceed \$37,000.00.

Additional safety measures (safety lights, City logo, etc.) will be added to the vehicle as needed.

FINANCIAL IMPACT:

The funding for the vehicle will be from the Public Works Administration Department (110-43100-59411) for the FY23/24 budget.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION:

Staff recommends approval of Resolution 23-08.
