WHEREAS, the department has five (5) surplus ventilation fans (4 gas powered and 1 electrical) that are no longer used and will be sold “as is”; and


WHEREAS, the department has migrated to a more reliable battery powered ventilation fan; and



PURPOSE:

The purpose of this resolution is to authorize the posting and sale of 5 ventilation fans on GovDeals.

BACKGROUND:

The Fire Department has had five (5) ventilation fans in storage. Four (4) of the fans were gas powered positive pressure fans and one (1) is an electrical negative pressure fan. These fans are not used any longer as the department has moved to all battery powered fans.

FINANCIAL IMPACT:

There is no financial impact to the city other than revenue collected on the sale.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION:

Staff recommends approval of Resolution 24-23 to:

1. To advertise and sell the 5 surplus ventilation fans on GovDeals.
