

Resolution No. 24-41

A RESOLUTION DESIGNATING SPRING HILL REPRESENTATIVE TO THE WILLIAMSON COUNTY COMPREHENSIVE GROWTH PLAN COORDINATING COMMITTEE.

WHEREAS, the City of Spring Hill has worked collaboratively with all of the Williamson County municipalities to propose new Urban Growth Boundaries for municipal jurisdictions; and

WHEREAS, Tennessee Code §6-58-104(a)(1)(B) indicates that the mayor of each municipality or the mayor's designee, as confirmed by the municipal governing body, shall serve as that municipality's representative to the coordinating committee; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor of Spring Hill has designated Alderman Trent Linville as the mayor's designee to the Williamson County Coordinating Committee; and


