

RESOLUTION 24-280

A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE EMERGENCY REPAIRS TO THE LIBRARY

WHEREAS, the metal beam and joists that support the floor under a section of the Spring Hill Public Library, including the restrooms, are failing due to rust and corrosion from extensive water damage; and

WHEREAS, the restrooms located within this space are critical to the operations of the library, both for the public and for the staff; and

WHEREAS, the purchasing manual of the City of Spring Hill allows for emergency purchases; and

WHEREAS, the City Staff request authorization to use general fund reserves to make the needed emergency repairs; and funds utilized from the reserves will be added to the Budget Amendment; and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the City of Spring Hill authorize emergency repairs and corresponding associated expenses described herein to repair the library.
