

RE: **To award the bid for the HVAC Replacement at Fire Station 3**

PURPOSE:

To award the bid for the replacement of the HVAC at Fire Station 3 to McClosky Mechanical.

BACKGROUND:

The HVAC unit at Fire Station 3 is no longer working and the Fire Station has been utilizing portable units and generators.

The City advertised proposals for the HVAC replacement for Fire Station 3 and bids were opened on September 5, 2024. After careful review and consideration, staff would like to recommend McClosky Mechanical for the HVAC replacement.

The City received two low bids for the replacement, however, Efficient HVAC did not visit the site as required in the RFP.

McClosky met all the requirements in the RFP and based on all pricing, was the only low bidder to meet these requirements.

FINANCIAL IMPACT:

The total cost for the HVAC replacement is \$69,400.00. The expenditure would be paid from currently budgeted funds in the facilities budget (520-41800-52651).

STAFF RECOMMENDATION:

Staff recommends approval of Resolution 24-235 to approve the replacement of the HVAC at Fire Station 3 and award the bid to McCloskey Mechanical.
