

ORDINANCE NO. 14-25

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 1, SECTION 14-101 REGARDING THE
CREATION AND MEMBERSHIP OF THE MUNICIPAL PLANNING COMMISSION**

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Board of Mayor and Aldermen that the Mayor be allowed to appoint two (2) additional Planning Commissioners resulting in the Planning Commission being a seven (7) member body, and to otherwise amend Chapter 1, Section 14-101 of the Spring Hill Municipal Code to comply with Tenn. Code Ann. §13-4-101, *et seq.*

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SPRING HILL as follows:

14-101. Creation and membership. Pursuant to the provisions of Tennessee Code Annotated §13-4-101, there is hereby created a municipal planning commission, hereinafter referred to as the planning commission. The planning commission shall consist of seven (7) members; two (2) of these shall be the mayor and another member of the board of mayor and aldermen selected by the board of mayor and aldermen; the other five (5) members shall be appointed by the mayor. All members of the planning commission shall serve as such without compensation. Except for the initial appointments, the terms of the five (5) members appointed by the mayor shall be for three (3) years each. The first three (3) members first appointed shall be appointed for terms of one (1), two (2), and three (3), respectively; the other two (2) members appointed shall be appointed for the same terms as the first and second members, respectively, so that the term of two (2) members expires one year for two consecutive years and the term of one member expires every third year. The terms of the mayor and the member selected by the board of mayor and aldermen shall run concurrently with their terms of office. Any vacancy in an appointive membership shall be filled for the unexpired term by the mayor. The mayor shall also have authority to remove any appointed member at the member's discretion.

That all other ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.


