

**ORDINANCE 12-21**

**AN ORDINANCE TO LIMIT PARKING ON PUBLIC STREETS  
IN RESIDENTIAL ZONED PROPERTY**

WHEREAS, the Board of Mayor and Alderman by passage of this Ordinance, hereby amends the Spring Hill Municipal Code by adding the following paragraph as a newly designated section to be numbered, Title 15, Chapter 6, Section 15-608, and shall state as follows:


**15-608. *Parking of Commercial Vehicles and Motorhomes on Public Streets in Residential Zones Restricted.***

- a. No person shall park any motor vehicle licensed and/or primarily used for commercial purposes, continuously for more than three (3) days on any public street in residentially zoned districts. This restriction includes school busses or trailers attached or attachable to any commercial vehicle.***
- b. No motor homes, trailers, boats with trailers, campers, fifth wheel or other recreational vehicles shall be permitted to be parked on any public street, continuously for more than three (3) days, in residentially zoned districts.***
- c. Excluded from this section entirely are emergency service vehicles and other vehicles actively performing a service for a residential property, including moving vans and vehicles needed for construction purposes.***

NOW THEREFORE IT BE FURTHER ORDAINED, that the Spring Hill City Code be amended by this Ordinance to restrict and limit parking in residentially zoned property; and


BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, that all Ordinances or Partial Ordinances in conflict herewith be, and the same hereby repealed.
