

**ORDINANCE NO. 06-37**

**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE MUNICIPAL CODE ON BEER  
PERMITS, TITLE 8, CHAPTER 2, SECTION 8-226**

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Spring Hill may, pursuant to it's charter and general laws of the State of Tennessee, enact regulatory ordinances protecting and promoting the general welfare, health and safety of its citizens.

**BE IT THEREFORE ORDAINED BY THE BOAR OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN  
OF THE CITY OF SPRING HILL, TENNESSEE:**

That Title 8, Chapter 2, Section 8-226, be and is, hereby amended as follows:

The second paragraph of Section 8-226 be deleted in its entirety and substituted therefor the following paragraph;

Upon the determination by the Beer Board that any violation has occurred under any provision of this chapter or the beer laws of the State of Tennessee, the Beer Board shall have the authority to suspend the beer permit for a period of time as determined by the nature of the offense. Upon the determination by the Beer Board of a first violation the permit holder shall be fined not less than \$500.00 and have its permit suspended for three (3) days. The maximum punishment for a first offense shall be a \$500.00 fine with the permit being suspended for a period of time not to exceed one (1) week.

For a second violation the permit holder shall be fined not less than \$1,000.00 and have its permit suspended for fifteen (15) days. The maximum punishment for a second offense shall be a \$1,000.00 fine with the permit being suspended for a period of time not to exceed thirty (30) days.

For a third or subsequent violation the permit holder shall be fined in the amount of \$2,500.00 and have the permit suspended for a period of one (1) year (365 days). (Ord #92-2, Jan. 1992, as amended by Ord #00-42, Dec. 2000)


**BE IT FURTHER ENACTED**, that any ordinances, or parts of ordinances, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

**BE IT FURTHER ENACTED**, that this ordinance shall take effect from and after its adoption, the public welfare requiring it.


