

ORDINANCE NO. 03-18

DID NOT PASS

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF SPRING HILL BY CHANGING TITLE 10, CHAPTER 1, SECTION 10-102, ANIMAL CONTROL

WHEREAS, the Board of Mayor and Aldermen for the City of Spring Hill may, pursuant to its charter and general laws of the State of Tennessee, enact regulatory ordinances protecting and promoting the general welfare, health and safety of its citizens.

BE IT THEREFORE ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF SPRING HILL, TENNESSEE, THAT TITLE 10, CHAPTER 1, SECTION 10-102, IS CHANGED TO READ AS FOLLOWS;

1. Delete Section 10-102 in its entirety and substitute in lieu thereof the following section;
2. **10-102. Keeping near a residence or business restricted.** No person shall keep any animal enumerated in the preceding section within one thousand (1,000) feet of any residence, place of business or public street.

BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, that any Ordinance or parts of Ordinances that are in conflict herewith be, and the same hereby are, repealed.

BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, that this ordinance shall take effect from and after its adoption, the public welfare requiring it.
