

ORDINANCE NO. 01-06

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE ZONING ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF SPRING HILL, TENNESSEE,

WHEREAS, the Board of Mayor and Aldermen for the City of Spring Hill may, pursuant to its charter and general laws of the State of Tennessee, enact and amend zoning ordinance regulations in accordance with a comprehensive plan for the purpose of promoting the public health, safety, morals, convenience, order, prosperity and general welfare of the community.

BE IT THEREFORE ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF SPRING HILL, TENNESSEE:

- (1) That Article III, Definitions, of the Zoning Ordinance of the City of Spring Hill, Tennessee, is hereby amended by adding the following:

Sexually Oriented Businesses: Any adult bookstore, motion picture theater or commercial establishment which, for a fee or incidental to another service, such as the serving of beer or other alcoholic beverages, sells or presents material or exhibition distinguished or characterized by a predominant emphasis on matter depicting explicit sexual activities or partially or completely uncovered human genitals or mammary glands.

- (2) That Article III, Section 3, (M-3) Industrial District (Special), Subsection 3.2, Uses Permitted on Appeal, is hereby amended by adding 3.2(2.9), Commercial uses that comply with the City of Spring Hill Ordinance regulating sexually oriented businesses.


All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
