

## **ORDINANCE NO. 01-15**

### **AMENDMENT OF TITLE 8, CHAPTER 3 OF THE SPRING HILL MUNICIPAL CODE**

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Mayor and Aldermen desires to amend the Municipal Code so as to amend Title 8, Chapter 3.

**NOW THEREFORE**, in consideration of the premises, be it hereby ordained by the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Spring Hill, Tennessee, that Title 8, Chapter 3 of the Spring Hill Municipal Code relative to the issuance of licenses for the retail sale of intoxicating liquor is hereby amended as follows:

1. Section 8-102 of the Spring Hill Municipal Code is amended to add new subparagraph (12) as follows:  
(12) The term "person" shall include natural person, corporation, partnership, limited liability company and unincorporated association.
2. Section 8-105 of the Spring Hill Municipal Code is deleted in its entirety and the following substituted therefor:  
  
8-105. **Issuance of licenses for retail sales.** For the retail sale of intoxicating liquor a license may be issued as herein provided. Any person or persons desiring to sell intoxicating liquor to patrons or customers, in sealed packages only, and not for consumption on the premises, shall make application to the city recorder for a retailers license. The application shall be in writing on forms prescribed and furnished by the City recorder. Subject to the issuance of a retail license by the Commissioner for Finance and Taxation of the State of Tennessee, a majority of the Board of Mayor and Aldermen may issue the retailer's license. The retailer's license shall not be issued unless and until the applicant therefor pays the city recorder a license fee of two


hundred and fifty dollars (\$250.00). (1987 Code, Section 2-105)

3. Section 8-109 (12) of the Spring Hill Municipal Code is deleted in its entirety.

**BE IT FURTHER ENACTED**, that all ordinances or partial ordinances in conflict herewith be and the same hereby are repealed or modified as the case may be.

**BE IT FURTHER ENACTED** that this ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage the public welfare demanding it.
