

ORDINANCE NO. 01-33

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF SPRING HILL SETTING NEW SPEED LIMITS ON COLUMBIA HIGHWAY (US31)

WHEREAS, the Board of Mayor and Aldermen for the City of Spring Hill may, pursuant to its charter and general laws of the State of Tennessee, enact regulatory ordinances protecting and promoting the general welfare, health and safety of its citizens.

BE IT THEREFORE ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF SPRING HILL, TENNESSEE:

(1) That Chapter 3, Section 15-305, Paragraph 5, Establishing 45 MPH Speed Limits, Subparagraphs (5a) and (5d) be amended to read as follows:


(5a) on Route 31 from the mid-point between First Baptist Church and Witt Hill subdivision to the Northern boundary of the City Limits.

(5d) on Route 31 from the Northern boundary of the City Limits to the mid-point between First Baptist Church and Witt Hill subdivision.


BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, that any Ordinance or parts of Ordinances that are in conflict herewith be, and the same hereby are, repealed.
