

ORDINANCE 01-37

AN ORDINANCE CREATING A BOARD OF ZONING APPEALS

Whereas, the members of the Spring Hill Regional Planning Commission serve also as the members of the Spring Hill Board of Zoning Appeals, and


Whereas, for just cause, it is the intent of the governing Board to create a distinct and independent Board of Zoning Appeals.

BE IT THEREFORE ORDAINED, BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF SPRING HILL, TENNESSEE that a Board of Zoning Appeals shall be created with (5) members, one of which shall be an Alderman not serving on the Planning Commission, who is to be approved by the governing Board of the City and the remaining four (4) members shall be appointed by the Mayor. The term of office shall be for a period of four (4) years with the alderman's term coinciding with his/her elected term of office.


BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that all ordinances, or partial ordinances in conflict herewith be, and the same hereby are, repealed or modified as the case by be.
