

ORDINANCE NO. 01-50

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF SPRING HILL SETTING NEW SPEED LIMITS ON KEDRON ROAD, DUPLEX ROAD, BUCKNER ROAD AND MAIN STREET (US 31)

WHEREAS, the Board of Mayor and Aldermen for the City of Spring Hill may, pursuant to its charter and general laws of the State of Tennessee, enact regulatory ordinances protecting and promoting the general welfare, health and safety of its citizens.


BE IT THEREFORE ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF SPRING HILL, TENNESSEE:

- (1) That Chapter 3, Section 15-305, Paragraph 3a and 3c, Establishing 30 MPH Speed Limits on Kedron Road, Main Street (US31), Duplex road and Buckner road be deleted in their entirety.
- (2) That Chapter 3, Section 15-305, Paragraph 4, Establishing 35MPH speed limits, be amended to include Subparagraph (c) "On Kedron Road from the East end of Orphanage Creek to Main Street (US31).
- (3) That Chapter 3, Section 15-305, Paragraph 4, Establishing 35 MPH speed limits, be amended to include Subparagraph (d) "On Main Street (US31) from the midpoint between The First Baptist Church and Witt Hill subdivision to the South end of the McCormack Creek Bridge.
- (4) That Chapter 3, Section 15-305, Paragraph 4, Establishing 35 MPH speed limits, be amended to include Subparagraph (e) " On Duplex road from Main Street to the Easternmost City Limits at I 65.
- (5) That Chapter 3, Section 15-305, Paragraph 4, Establishing 35 MPH speed limits, be amended to include Subparagraph (f) "On Buckner road from (US31) Columbia Pike, to Buckner Lane.


BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, that any Ordinance or parts of Ordinances that are in conflict herewith be, and the same hereby are, repealed.

BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, that this ordinance shall take effect from and after its adoption, the public welfare requiring it.


