**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 1, SECTION 1-105,  
PARAGRAPH 3, TERMS OF OFFICE, OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE  
OF THE CITY OF SPRING HILL, TENNESSEE**


**WHEREAS**, the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Spring Hill may, pursuant to it's charter and general laws of the State of Tennessee, enact regulatory ordinances protecting and promoting the general welfare, health, and safety of it's citizens.


**BE IT THEREFORE ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF  
MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF SPRING HILL,  
TENNESSEE:**


That Paragraph 3, Section 1-105, be deleted in its entirety and inserted instead thereof; "The term of the Mayor of the City of Spring Hill shall be for a period of four years commencing at the next regular election in the year 2001. In 2001 and thereafter a mayor will be elected every four years."

**BE IT FURTHER ENACTED**, that this ordinance shall take effect from and after it's adoption, the public welfare requiring it.
