

ORDINANCE NO. 00-28

**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND TITLE 8, CHAPTER 1, SECTION 8-116,
SUB-PARAGRAPH 10, OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF
SPRING HILL, TENNESSEE**


WHEREAS, the Board of Mayor and Aldermen desires to amend Title 8, Chapter 1, Section 8-116 Sub-Paragraph 10, of the Municipal Code for the City of Spring Hill relative to the provisions governing the placement of signs on liquor stores within the corporate limits;

WHEREAS, the Board of Mayor and Aldermen has reviewed such provisions and conducted a public hearing on this matter.


BE IT THEREFORE ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF SPRING HILL, TENNESSEE, that, Title 8, Chapter 1, Section 8-116, Sub-paragraph 10, of the Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

- (a) "...a sign in letters not larger than eight (8) inches in height or a neon or electric sign.....".
- (b) The last sentence in this paragraph is hereby deleted in its entirety.
