

ORDINANCE NO. 99-19

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE TOWN OF SPRING HILL SETTING NEW SPEED LIMITS ON U.S. 31, MAIN STREET.

WHEREAS, the Board of Mayor and Aldermen for the Town of Spring Hill may, pursuant to its charter and general laws of the State of Tennessee, enact regulatory ordinances protecting and promoting the general welfare, health and safety of its citizens.

BE IT THEREFORE ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE TOWN OF SPRING HILL, TENNESSEE:

(1) That Chapter 3, Section 15-305, Paragraph 3a, be amended to read as follows:

(3a) on Route 31 (Main Street) from a point 300 feet south of the southern edge of the "Hitchin Post" tract to the south end of the McCormack Street Bridge.

(2) That Chapter 3, Section 15-305, Paragraph 6a, be amended to read as follows:

(6a) on Route 31, (Main Street) from the northern edge of the "Hitchin Post" tract to a point 300 feet south of the southern edge of the "Hitchin Post" tract.

BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that this ordinance shall take effect from and after its adoption, the public welfare requiring it.
