

ORDINANCE NO. 99-33

AN ORDINANCE TO ANNEX THE ENTIRE ROAD RIGHT-OF-WAY OF U.S. 31/SR6 FROM THE NORTHERN BOUNDARY OF OLD BUCKNER ROAD TO THE NORTHERN BOUNDARY OF THE RANDOLPH SHIRLING, JR., PROPERTY AS SHOWN ON WILLIAMSON COUNTY TAX MAP 153, PARCEL 25, AND LYING WITHIN THE CITY LIMITS OF SPRING HILL

WHEREAS, it appears to the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the Town of Spring Hill that the prosperity of the Town of Spring Hill and the affected territory will be materially retarded unless the territory is annexed to the corporate limits of the Town of Spring Hill, and;

WHEREAS, the property owner listed in this Ordinance 99-33 has requested annexation in order to insure the value and availability of her property to future developers, and

WHEREAS, the natural growth area of the Town of Spring Hill will include these parcels

BE IT THEREFORE ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE TOWN OF SPRING HILL, TENNESSEE that:

That pursuant to T.C.A 6-51-101, et seq., the property vested in the State of Tennessee, namely the entire right-of-way of U.S. 31/SR6, from the northern boundary of Old Buckner Road as it crosses to the western boundary of U.S. 31/SR6, to the northern boundary of the Randolph Shirling, Jr., property as shown on Williamson County Tax Map 153, Parcel 25, as it crosses to the western boundary of U.S. 31/SR6.

Annexation of said territory adjoining the Town's existing boundaries is necessary for the welfare of the affected territory as well as the Town as a whole.

A map showing the said territory is available for inspection at Town Hall in Spring Hill, Tennessee.

This Ordinance was passed after the adoption of a plan of services for the property in conformity with and as provided by Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 6-51-102.


This Ordinance shall become effective thirty (30) days after its final passage.
