

ORDINANCE NO. 99-37

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE TOWN
OF SPRING HILL TO CHANGE THE REQUIREMENTS FOR
APPOINTING MEMBERS TO THE PARKS AND RECREATION
COMMISSION**

WHEREAS, the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the Town of Spring Hill may, pursuant to its charter and general laws of the State of Tennessee, enact regulatory ordinances protecting and promoting the general welfare, health and safety of its citizens.

**BE IT THEREFORE ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR
AND ALDERMEN OF THE TOWN OF SPRING HILL, TENNESSEE:**

That Section 2-201 of Title 2, Chapter 2, be deleted in its entirety and inserted in lieu thereof the following:


“2-201. Organization and appointment of members. There shall be a Parks and Recreation Commission of the Town of Spring Hill, Tennessee (here in after referred to as “the Commission”), which shall serve as the governing board of the parks and recreation programs and facilities of the town subject to the actions and policies of the Board of Mayor and Aldermen.

The commission shall be constituted as a body of five (5) members. Four (4) members shall be appointed at-large from within the town limits. The members shall be appointed by majority vote of the membership of the Board of Mayor and Aldermen. The Mayor shall appoint a fifth member who shall be an Alderman and shall serve as chairman of the commission.


Members of the commission shall serve without compensation, but may be reimbursed for reasonable and necessary expenses.”

BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, that this ordinance shall take effect from and after its adoption, the public welfare requiring it.
