

ORDINANCE No. 98-9

AN ORDINANCE TO ANNEX PROPERTY
BELONGING TO RANDOLPH R. SHIRLING, JR.,
SUCH PROPERTY FRONTS ON OLD BUCKNER ROAD
AND U.S. HIGHWAY 31,
WILLIAMSON COUNTY TAX MAP 153, PARCEL 25,
CONSISTING OF 65.5 ACRES, MORE OR LESS

Whereas, it appears to the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the Town of Spring Hill that the prosperity of the Town of Spring Hill and the affected territory will be materially retarded unless the territory is annexed to the corporate limits of the Town of Spring Hill, and

Whereas, the property owner listed in this Ordinance 98-9 has requested annexation in order to insure the value and availability of his property to future developers, and

Whereas, the natural growth area of the Town of Spring Hill will include this parcel

BE IT THEREFORE ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE TOWN OF SPRING HILL, TENNESSEE that:

Pursuant to Tennessee Code Annotated Section 6-51-101 et seq., the property vested in property owners as hereinafter listed in Williamson County, Tennessee, being a part of Williamson County Tax Maps 153, Parcel 25, fronting on Old Buckner Road and U.S. Highway 31, totaling 65.5 acres, more or less, is hereby annexed to the corporate limits of the Town of Spring Hill and made a part thereof. Note: The portion of Buckner Road adjacent to this property is now known, by common usage but necessarily by name of record, as "Old Buckner Road" because a new Buckner Road is being constructed south of this property.

Annexation of said territory adjoining the Town's existing boundaries is necessary for the welfare of the affected territory as well as the Town as a whole.


A map showing the said territory is available for inspection at Town Hall in Spring Hill, Tennessee.

This ordinance was passed after the adoption of a plan of services for the property in conformity with and as provided by Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 6-51-102.

This ordinance shall become effective thirty (30) days after its final passage.

This ordinance was passed on second reading after a public hearing before the Board of Mayor and Aldermen on May 18, 1998, and after due publication in Car Country News on April 29, 1998.

Passed and adopted by the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the Town of Spring Hill, Tennessee on the 18th day of May, 1998.




