

**AN ORDINANCE TO DEANNEX PROPERTY
BELONGING TO THE STATE OF TENNESSEE, PROPERTY
CONSISTS OF A PORTION OF THE RIGHT OF WAY
OF INTERSTATE 65 IN THE VICINITY
OF THE INTERSECTION WITH STATE ROUTE 396 (SATURN PARKWAY
AND CONTIGUOUS TO THE EASTERN BOUNDARIES OF THE TOWN**

Whereas, Interstate 65 which is property owned by the State of Tennessee is not in the projected growth pattern of the Town since it is the present intent of the governing body to stop all growth served by city services on the west side of Interstate 65, and

Whereas, Interstate 65, now located inside the corporate boundaries, serves no useful purpose to the Town and should be deannexed as being not vital to the interests of the Town or in the future growth pattern of the town

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE TOWN OF SPRING HILL, TENNESSEE that property owned by the State of Tennessee, being a portion of Interstate 65, as described in the caption, be deannexed and that the zoning map be modified to show revised corporate boundaries not to include such property.

Be if further ordained that one insignificant portion of this territory will remain inside the corporate boundaries; Specifically one two lane bridge serving as part of Jim Warren Road and serving properties located east of Interstate 65 shall remain inside the corporate boundaries of Spring Hill.
