

**AN ORDINANCE TO BAN THROUGH TRUCK TRAFFIC
ON OLD KEDRON ROAD, MCLEMORE STREET AND HUGHES STREET IN ORDER TO
MAINTAIN PUBLIC SAFETY ON NARROW STREETS**

Whereas, Old Kedron Road, McLemore Street and Hughes Street are now being used by delivery trucks bringing construction materials to subdivisions on Duplex Road, and

Whereas, this construction is reasonably predicted to continue for years to come, and

Whereas, these streets are too narrow for truck traffic and further are populated by families with children and are considered local neighborhood streets only in the classifications of streets by the governing Board, and

Whereas, the minor arterials and collectors of the Town should be used by delivery trucks instead of local streets, and


Whereas, routes on collectors and arterials are readily available for these deliveries of construction materials

BE IT THEREFORE ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE TOWN OF SPRING HILL, TENNESSEE that:

"Through truck traffic shall be prohibited on Old Kedron Road, McLemore Street and Hughes Street and that signs stipulating such shall be ordered and placed as soon as possible by the public works department of the Town of Spring Hill"


This ordinance was passed on second reading after a public hearing before the Board of Mayor and Aldermen on July 20, 1998.
