

AN ORDINANCE TO ANNEX FROM MAURY COUNTY  
A PORTION OF TOM LUNN ROAD, A MAURY COUNTY ROAD,  
COMMENCING AT THE INTERSECTION  
OF TOM LUNN AND JOHN LUNN ROAD  
AND EXTENDING EASTWARD TO THE COMMON INTERSECTION  
OF TOM LUNN, NEW DERRYBERRY ROAD AND PORT ROYAL ROADS

Whereas, it appears to the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the Town of Spring Hill that the prosperity of the Town of Spring Hill and the affected territory will be materially retarded unless the territory is annexed to the corporate limits of the Town of Spring Hill, and

Whereas, the natural growth areas of the Town of Spring Hill will include the parcels as listed in this Ordinance 98-28, and

Whereas, this section of Tom Lunn Road will be encompassed on both sides by property within the corporate boundaries of the Town

BE IT THEREFORE ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE TOWN OF SPRING HILL, TENNESSEE that:

Pursuant to Tennessee Code Annotated Section 6-51-101 et seq., the property owned by Maury County, Tennessee, being a part of Tom Lunn Road located between the common intersection of Tom Lunn Road with John Lunn Road and the common intersection of Tom Lunn with New Derryberry Road and Port Royal Roads and bordered by Royal Park Industrial Park on one side and the James Lochridge property on the other side, both private properties being inside the corporate boundaries of the Town, is hereby annexed to the corporate limits of the Town of Spring Hill and made a part thereof.

Annexation of said territory adjoining the Town's existing boundaries is necessary for the welfare of the affected territory as well as the Town as a whole.

A map showing the said territory is available for inspection at Town Hall in Spring Hill, Tennessee.

This ordinance was passed after the adoption of a plan of services for the property in conformity with and as provided by Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 6-51-102.

This ordinance shall become effective thirty (30) days after its final passage.



Passed and adopted by the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the Town of Spring Hill, Tennessee on the 17th day of August, 1998.




