

ORDINANCE No. 97-24

AN ORDINANCE TO ANNEX THE FRED SELLE PROPERTY
FRONTING ON DUPLEX ROAD
AS SHOWN ON MAURY COUNTY TAX MAP 28, PARCEL 5.01,
23.69 ACRES, MORE OR LESS

Whereas, it appears to the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the Town of Spring Hill that the prosperity of the Town of Spring Hill and the affected territory will be materially retarded unless the territory is annexed to the corporate limits of the Town of Spring Hill

BE IT THEREFORE ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE TOWN OF SPRING HILL, TENNESSEE that:

Pursuant to Tennessee Code Annotated Section 6-51-101 et seq., the property vested in property owner, Fred Selle, in Maury County, Tennessee being a part of Maury County Tax Map 28, (a part of) Parcel 5.01, fronting on State Route 247 (Duplex Road) consisting of 23.69 acres more or less is hereby annexed to the corporate limits of the Town of Spring Hill and made a part thereof.


Annexation of said territory adjoining the Town's existing boundaries is necessary for the welfare of the affected territory as well as the Town as a whole.

A map showing the said territory is available for inspection at Town Hall in Spring Hill, Tennessee.

This ordinance was passed after the adoption of a plan of services for the property in conformity with as provided by Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 6-51-102.


This ordinance shall become effective thirty (30) days after its final passage.


