

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND TITLE 15, SECTION 15-121,
OF THE SPRING HILL MUNICIPAL CODE
BY REQUIRING BICYCLE RIDERS UNDER 18 YEARS OF AGE
TO WEAR SAFETY HELMETS


Whereas, it has come to the attention of the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the Town of Spring Hill, Tennessee that the youth of the Town are in jeopardy if not wearing safety helmets while riding bicycles; and

Whereas, the governing Board has a responsibility to protect children in Spring Hill from the hazards of traffic and unnecessary risk

BE IT THEREFORE ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE TOWN OF SPRING HILL, TENNESSEE that Title 15, Section 15-121 of the Spring Hill Municipal Code is amended by adding words at the end of the last paragraph as follows: "This requirement for safety helmets shall also apply to any person under the age of 18 years who is riding a bicycle upon the public right of way."


