

**AN ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH POLICIES AND RATES
FOR THE USE OF THE PARKS BUILDING AND THE
TOWN HALL COMMUNITY ROOM, CONFERENCE ROOM, OFFICES, AND
COURTROOM/BOARD CHAMBERS OF THE TOWN OF SPRING HILL**

Whereas, the parks building and the Town Hall community room, conference room, offices, and courtroom/Board chambers of Spring Hill are available for public use throughout each week;

Whereas, the use of these facilities requires expenditures by the Town for furniture, furniture repair, maintenance, energy, and other miscellany associated with use; and

Whereas, contribution from user parties is needed to assist in annual expense.

BE IT THEREFORE ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE TOWN OF SPRING HILL, TENNESSEE that the following policies and schedule of rates for use of these facilities is determined by the Board of Mayor and Aldermen to be equitable and in the public interest:

Section One. User group categories.

Those organizations characterized as "public service organizations" are those (a) having a community wide service orientation, (b) engaged in activities designed to benefit the whole community of Spring Hill, (c) not seeking use of Town facilities to promulgate particular political, religious, social, economic, or other partisan ideological beliefs, (d) not advocating violence, harassment, intimidation, or other conduct disruptive of peace and order, and (e) not discriminating on the basis of race, religion, gender, country of origin, or age (legitimate membership requirements are permissible).

Section Two. Rates to be paid.

1. A full day rate is to be charged for any part of a day.
2. Rate charges for Parks Building and Town Hall facilities:

A. Public service organizations: No charge

B. Other groups:

Parks Building and Town Hall community room: \$35.00 per day for Spring Hill residents,
\$50.00 per day for others

Town Hall Courtroom: \$75 per day


Town Hall conference room: \$25 per day

Town Hall offices: \$25 per day

Section Three. Administrative and appeal rights.

The City Administrator will have the authority to administer the use of the facilities, develop application forms for persons requesting use of facilities, recommend rate adjustments to the Board, and forbid use of the facilities to groups deemed to be irresponsible in their care of the facilities. Any group not in agreement with a decision of the City Administrator may file an appeal to be heard by the Board of Mayor and Aldermen at a regular or special called meeting.
