

ORDINANCE NO. 96-30

**AN ORDINANCE TO CREATE A DEDICATED FUND
FOR PURCHASE OF EQUIPMENT NEEDED FOR ENFORCEMENT
OF TRAFFIC LAWS IN SPRING HILL**

Whereas, the police department of Spring Hill has a continuing need for purchase and replacement of equipment used in the enforcement of traffic laws;

Whereas, there is a well known practice by municipalities of creating dedicated funds for this purpose to be taken from revenue produced by police work and Spring Hill needs to continuously add to the equipment pool;

BE IT THEREFORE ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE TOWN OF SPRING HILL, TENNESSEE that:


Effective July 1, 1996, every revenue producing traffic citation written by the Spring Hill police department will have ten dollars (\$10.00) from the revenue produced by such citation placed in a designated police department fund to be used by the police chief for the sole purpose of the purchase or replacement of traffic law enforcement related equipment. All purchases by the police department shall comply with the requirements of the Municipal Purchasing Law of the State of Tennessee, Tennessee Code Annotated sections 6-56-301 to 306. The police department will provide the Board of Mayor and Aldermen a report at each monthly Board meeting of the balance of the designated fund and any expenditures out of the fund.

Passed and adopted by the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the Town of Spring Hill, Tennessee, on the 16th day of September, 1996.




