

ORDINANCE NO. 96-3

AN ORDINANCE TO ENSURE THE VALIDITY OF ALL ORDINANCES WHICH HAVE PASSED SECOND READING FROM ORDINANCE 95-7, PASSED ON APRIL 17, 1995, THROUGH 95-25 INCLUSIVE, THESE ORDINANCES HAVING BEEN PASSED ON SECOND READING BETWEEN THE INCLUSION OF THE LAST ORDINANCE (ORDINANCE 95-5) TO BE INCLUDED IN THE SPRING HILL MUNICIPAL CODE REVISION DATED JULY, 1995 AS PREPARED BY THE MUNICIPAL TECHNICAL ADVISORY SERVICE AND THE PASSAGE OF ORDINANCE 95-26, DATED DECEMBER 18, 1995, WHICH ADOPTED THE JULY, 1995 REVISION OF THE SPRING HILL MUNICIPAL CODE

Whereas, the Town of Spring Hill periodically chooses to have the Spring Hill Municipal Code codified by the Municipal Technical Advisory Service (MTAS) to include ordinances passed since the preceding codification revision;

Whereas, of necessity, the legislative work of the Board of Mayor and Aldermen must continue in the interim period, and there are ordinances passed between the inclusion of a final ordinance in the revised codification of the Spring Hill Municipal Code and the passage of the ordinance which adopted the most recent Spring Hill Municipal Code revision;

Whereas, there is a potential for conflict about the legitimacy of these interim ordinances because these ordinances have neither been included in the revised Municipal Code nor were they passed after the adoption of the revised Municipal Code;

Whereas, the Board of Mayor and Aldermen wish to remove all doubt about legitimacy or legislative intent concerning these interim ordinances, the public interest requiring a strong certainty of ordinance legitimacy; and


Whereas, after notice on February 2, 1996, in the Columbia Daily Herald and the Franklin Review Appeal, a public hearing on this Ordinance was held on February 19, 1996 before final consideration of the Ordinance.

BE IT THEREFORE ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE TOWN OF SPRING HILL, TENNESSEE that the following be adopted to insure the validity of interim ordinances as hereinbefore described and to insure that the public is given notice of legislative intent, the public welfare requiring same:

All ordinances, having previously passed second reading, from and including Ordinance 95-7, passed on April 17, 1995 through Ordinance 95-25 passed on December 18, 1995, are hereby declared to be adopted by the Board of Mayor and Aldermen and shall be added as amendments to the revision of the Spring Hill Municipal Code dated July, 1995, as prepared by the Municipal Technical Advisory Service of the University of Tennessee.


