

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE SPRING HILL MUNICIPAL CODE
TO DESIGNATE SPEED LIMITS WITHIN CERTAIN AREAS
OF THE TOWN OF SPRING HILL**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE
TOWN OF SPRING HILL:

That Section 9 of the Spring Hill Municipal Code be
amended as follows:

1. By amending Section 9-112 by adding at the end of the
first paragraph the following:

"It shall likewise be unlawful for the operator of any
motor vehicle to operate the vehicle in the speed in excess of
thirty (30) miles per hour or in excess of a speed limit designated
by a traffic-controlled sign, marking, or device placed or erected
by the State, the Town, or the developer of a subdivision, or in
excess of any speed limit for a particular area designated in
Section 9-205 of the Code."

2. By adding at the end of Section 9-201 the following:

"It shall also be unlawful for any person to operate a
motor vehicle on any highway or street at a rate of speed in excess
of that set forth in Section 9-205 of this Code."

3. By adding at the end of Section 9-204 a new Section,
as follows:

"9-205. Speed limits imposed for specific areas. It
shall be unlawful for any person to operate or drive a motor
vehicle in excess of thirty (30) miles per hour in the Town of
Spring Hill or in excess of the speed limits herein designated for
the following specific areas of the Town of Spring Hill.

(a) The speed limit within the entire area of the
subdivision known as Spring Hill Estates is hereby fixed at twenty
(20) miles per hour.

(b) The speed limit within the entire area of the
subdivision known as Witt Hill Subdivision is hereby fixed at
twenty (20) miles per hour.
