BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE

That Ordinance No. 91-10, which required all new signs to
be submitted to and approved by the Board of Mayor and Aldermen, is
hereby repealed.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that all new signs within the Town
of Spring Hill be governed by the appropriate provisions of the
Spring Hill Zoning Ordinance.

1995.




