

ORDINANCE NO. 94-5

**AN ORDINANCE TO IMPOSE ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS
ON TEMPORARY AND TRANSIENT VENDORS OR PEDDLERS
AND TO AMEND CHAPTER 2 OF TITLE 5
OF THE SPRING HILL MUNICIPAL CODE ACCORDINGLY**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE TOWN OF SPRING HILL that Chapter 2 of Title 5 of the Spring Hill Municipal Code is amended by adding at the end thereof the following section:

Section 5-214. A transient vendor is hereby defined to be an individual who is not a resident of the Town of Spring Hill who intends to offer for sale goods or services within the Town of Spring Hill. A temporary vendor is hereby defined to be an individual who intends to offer goods or services for sale within the Town of Spring Hill only for special events or on an infrequent basis. In addition to all of the other requirements of this Chapter, either of such vendors shall be required to cause the bond required under Section 5-206 to contain an additional condition that the permittee shall remove all debris and refuse from the area occupied by such permittee in conducting its sales or other activities. In the event such permittee is unable to post this bond, it may in lieu thereof deposit the sum of One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) with the City Recorder, which will be returned to such permittee ten (10) days after the vendor ceases to operate within the Town of Spring Hill if at that time the Chief of Police certifies that all of the conditions of this Section and Section 5-206 have been satisfied. In addition to all other fees, any such

permittee shall likewise deposit the sum of Ten Dollars (\$10.00) for each day that it intends to be engaged in business within the Town of Spring Hill.
