


AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE MUNICIPAL ZONING
ORDINANCE AND THE ZONING MAP BY THE RECLASSIFICATION
OF ANOTHER PORTION OF THE OLD HIGH SCHOOL PROPERTY
ON THE EAST SIDE OF SCHOOL STREET
AND THE WEST SIDE OF WALNUT STREET
OWNED BY RAY WILLIAMS AND WIFE, CINDY C. WILLIAMS
FROM AN R-1 (LOW DENSITY RESIDENTIAL) DISTRICT
TO A B-4 (CENTRAL BUSINESS) DISTRICT

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE
TOWN OF SPRING HILL:

That the Spring Hill Municipal Zoning ordinance,
Ordinance No. 74-2, and the zoning map thereby adopted, as both
have been previously amended, are hereby further amended by the
rezoning of the properties of Ray Williams and wife, Cindy C.
Williams, acquired from the Maury County Board of Education on the
east side of School Street and the west side of Walnut Street
(being part of Tax Map 25-0, Group C, Parcel 5) from an R-1 (Low
Density Residential) District to a B-4 (Central Business) District.

This ordinance was passed on the recommendation of the
Spring Hill Regional Planning Commission made at its regular
meeting held on June 14, 1993, after due publication in the
Columbia Daily Herald.


