

AN ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH AN APPLICATION FEE  
OF \$250.00 FOR ANY ENTITY MAKING AN APPLICATION  
FOR A PERMIT TO SELL, DISTRIBUTE, STORE OR MANUFACTURE  
BEER WITHIN THE TOWN OF SPRING HILL AND  
TO IMPOSE AN ANNUAL FEE OF \$100.00 ON EACH  
SUCH PERMIT HOLDER PURSUANT TO THE PROVISIONS OF  
CHAPTER 297 OF THE PUBLIC ACTS OF THE  
1993 TENNESSEE GENERAL ASSEMBLY

Pursuant to and in conformity with Public Chapter 297 of the Acts of the 1993 Tennessee General Assembly, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE TOWN OF SPRING HILL:

SECTION 1: From and after the effective date of this ordinance each new applicant for a permit to sell beer within the city limits of the Town of Spring Hill shall be required to pay an application fee of \$250.00 to the Recorder. No portion of this fee shall be refunded to the applicant whether the application is approved or denied.

SECTION 2: There is hereby imposed on the business of selling, distributing, storing or manufacturing beer within the Town of Spring Hill an annual privilege tax of \$100.00, notwithstanding the provisions of Section 57-6-112 of Tennessee Code Annotated. Each holder of a beer permit shall remit this fee on January 1, 1994, and each successive January 1 thereafter to the Recorder of the Town of Spring Hill.

SECTION 3: The privilege tax hereby imposed shall be in addition to any and all other privilege taxes to which the holders of beer permits are subject.
