

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND
CHAPTER 8 OF TITLE 1
OF THE TENNESSEE MUNICIPAL CODE
TO ESTABLISH HOLIDAYS
FOR THE TOWN OF SPRING HILL
AND TO PROVIDE ADDITIONAL COMPENSATION
FOR MEMBERS OF THE POLICE FORCE
FOR SUCH DAYS

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE
TOWN OF SPRING HILL:

SECTION 1. That Title 1 of the Tennessee Municipal Code
is amended by adding a Section 1-805 as follows:

1-805. Holidays. The Town of Spring Hill will each
year officially recognize seven (7) holidays which
are New Year's Day, the 4th day of July,
Thanksgiving, Martin Luther King's Birthday (to be
celebrated the third Monday in January of each
year), Memorial Day, Labor Day and Christmas Day.
In the event any of these days fall on a Saturday
or Sunday, the holiday will be recognized the
following Monday.

SECTION 2. Chapter 8 of Title 1 of the Tennessee
Municipal Code is further amended by adding a Section 8-806 as
follows:

1-806. Additional Holiday Compensation for
Policemen. Each member of the police force of the
Town of Spring Hill shall be compensated for an
additional day for each holiday specified in Section
1-805 as follows: For each such holiday each
policeman shall be paid 1/260th of his annual
compensation. Each member of the police force shall
receive this additional compensation for each such
holiday whether or not work is performed on such
holiday.
