


AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE MUNICIPAL ZONING ORDINANCE
AND THE ZONING MAP BY THE RECLASSIFICATION OF THE
AUBREY AND BRENDA BAKER PROPERTY
(MAURY COUNTY TAX MAP 25, PARCEL 21)
ON DEPOT STREET
FROM A R-1 (LOW DENSITY RESIDENTIAL) DISTRICT TO A
B-1 (OFFICE AND LIMITED RETAIL COMMERCIAL) DISTRICT

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE
TOWN OF SPRING HILL:

That Ordinance No. 74-2 and the zoning map of the Town
of Spring Hill, as both have been previously amended, are hereby
further amended by the rezoning of the Aubrey and Brenda Baker
Property on Depot Street, Maury County Tax Map 25, Parcel 21, from
a R-1 (Low Density Residential) District to a B-1 (Office and
Limited Retail Commercial) District.

This ordinance was passed on the recommendation of the
Spring Hill Regional Planning Commission made at its regular
meeting held on October 8, 1990, after a public hearing held on
November 19, 1990, after legal notice of the meeting was duly
published in the Spring Hill Morning Sun more than seven (7) days
prior to the November 19, 1990, meeting.

the Town of Spring Hill on this the 19th day of November, 1990.
