

ORDINANCE 90-1

AN ORDINANCE TO ANNEX THE WOODARD AND CAMERON PROPERTIES ON THE NORTH SIDE OF BUCKNER ROAD, WILLIAMSON COUNTY, TAX MAP 154, PARCELS 62, 62.01 AND 63, AND BUCKNER ROAD FROM BUCKNER PLACE SUBDIVISION, TO BUCKNER LANE,

WHEREAS, the owners of properties designated as Tax Map 154, Parcels 62, 62.01 and 63 on the north side of Buckner, and Buckner Road from Buckner Place Subdivision, to Buckner Lane, Williamson County, have petitioned the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the Town of Spring Hill that these properties be annexed to its corporate limits; and

WHEREAS, it appears to the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the Town of Spring Hill, that the prosperity of the Town of Spring Hill and the Woodard and Cameron Properties located on the north side of Buckner Road, Williamson County, Tax Map 154, Parcels 62, 62.01 and 63, and Buckner Road from Buckner Place Subdivision, to Buckner Lane will be materially retarded and the safety and welfare of the inhabitants and the properties thereof endangered unless these properties are annexed to the corporate limits of the Town of Spring Hill;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the Town of Spring Hill, that the Woodard and Cameron Properties on the north side of Buckner Road, Williamson County, Tax Map 154, Parcels 62, 62.01 and 63, and Buckner Road from Buckner Place Subdivision, to Buckner Lane, be annexed to and become a part of the corporate limits of the Town of Spring Hill.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the Board of Mayor and Aldermen deems the annexation of these properties to be necessary

for the welfare of the residents and property owners of the area annexed as well as the municipality as a whole.

This Ordinance was passed after the adoption of the Plan of Services for the area proposed to be annexed in conformity with and as provided by Section 6-51-102 of Tennessee Code Annotated.

Passed and adopted by the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the Town of Spring Hill on this the 15th day of January, 1990.




