

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE SPRING HILL MUNICIPAL
ZONING ORDINANCE AND THE ZONING MAP
BY THE RECLASSIFICATION OF THE CAMERON PROPERTY
(WILLIAMSON COUNTY TAX MAP 154, PARCELS 62 AND 62.01)
TO AN R-1 (LOW DENSITY RESIDENTIAL) DISTRICT

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the
Town of Spring Hill:

That the Spring Hill Municipal Zoning Ordinance,
Ordinance No. 74-2, and the zoning map thereby adopted, as
previously amended, be further amended by the reclassification of
the Cameron Property on the north margin of Buckner Road and the
west margin of Buckner Lane (Williamson County Tax Map 154, Parcels
62 and 62.01), to an R-1 (Low Density Residential) District.

This Ordinance was adopted on second reading on April 16,
1990, after a public hearing held on that date, after due
publication in the Columbia Daily Herald, the Spring Hill Morning
Sun, and the Franklin Review Appeal on the recommendation of the
Spring Hill Regional Planning Commission at a meeting held on March
26, 1990.

Passed and adopted by the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of
the Town of Spring Hill on this the 16th day of April, 1990.
