

ORDINANCE NO. 89-01

(As Amended on Second Reading)

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 2 OF TITLE 11 OF THE SPRING HILL MUNICIPAL CODE AND ORDINANCE NO. 88-06, THE ORDINANCE RE-ENACTING THE STREET GRAPHICS ORDINANCE:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE TOWN OF SPRING HILL:

That Chapter 2 of Title 11 of the Spring Hill Municipal Code and Ordinance No. 88-06 be amended as follows:

1. That Section 1.2(4) Amortization, be amended by adding at the end of subsection (a) the following:

"; provided, however, that the provisions of this section shall not apply to street graphics erected by churches, fraternal lodges, or charitable organizations."

2. That subsection 1.5(15) is amended to read as follows:

"1.5(15) Temporary graphics, not to exceed three (3) in number, each of which shall total not over twenty-four (24) square feet of surface area pertaining to auctions in all districts may be displayed on the day of the event and fifteen (15) days prior to the event to which the pertain. One (1) of the three (3) such graphics may be displayed on the property where the auction will be conducted and two (2) may be displayed on other sites if approved by the Building Inspector, provided, however, that on property fronting on two or more streets, one sign may be displayed on each street.

3. Section 1.6(2) which pertains to residential subdivision and multi-family residential development entrance graphics is amended by deleting from subsection (c)(1) the words and figures "one hundred (100) feet" and inserting in lieu thereof "fifty (50) feet".
