

ORDINANCE NUMBER 87-18A

AN ORDINANCE TO ANNEX CERTAIN PROPERTY LYING ON THE SOUTH SIDE OF BUCKNER ROAD TO THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE TOWN OF SPRING HILL

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE TOWN OF SPRING HILL:

WHEREAS, a majority of the residents and property owners of the areas hereinafter described have petitioned the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the Town of Spring Hill that these areas be annexed to its corporate limits; and

WHEREAS, it appears to the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the Town of Spring Hill that the prosperity of the Town of Spring Hill and the territory hereinafter described which is proposed to be annexed will be materially retarded and the safety and welfare of the inhabitants and property thereof endangered unless this territory is annexed to the corporate limits of the Town of Spring Hill;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE TOWN OF SPRING HILL that the following described areas on the South side of Buckner Road in Williamson County be annexed to and become part of the corporate limits of the Town of Spring Hill, to-wit:

1. The property of Ralph Cravens which is bounded on the North by Buckner Road, on the South by Martin on the East by Robert Watts, and on the West by Plant and being designated as Tax Map 153, Parcel 28.
2. The property of Stewart Campbell, Jr., which is bounded on the North by Buckner Road, on the South by Stewart Campbell, East by Yannelli and West by Loudenslager, being designated as Tax Map 153, Parcel 29.03.

3. The property of Randall Biggers which is bounded on the North by Buckner Road, East by Jones and Campbell, South by Campbell and West by Yannelli, being designated as Tax Map 153, Parcel 29.05.
4. The property of Stewart Campbell, Sr., which is bounded on the North by Buckner Road, South by Campbell, West by Biggers and Jones and being designated as Tax Map 153, Parcel 65.04


BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the Board of Mayor and Aldermen deem the annexation of the above described property to be necessary for the welfare of the residents and property owners of the area annexed hereby as well as the municipality as a whole.

This Ordinance was passed on third reading after a public hearing was held on October 19, 1987, after notice thereof was duly published in the Columbia Daily Herald and Williamson County Leader on September 25, 1987, and in the Spring Hill Morning Sun on September 24, 1987.

This Ordinance was further adopted after the adoption of a Plan of Services for the areas proposed to be annexed in conformity with and as provided by Sec. 6-51-102 of Tennessee Code Annotated.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that this Ordinance shall become operative thirty (30) days after the final passage thereof.


